## From the Bishop: Keep Practicing Hope

"Advent affirms the hope that God's word is always breaking in for our good," says Bishop Dan Schwerin of the Northern Illinois-Wisconsin Episcopal Area, in an Advent reflection. In these discouraging days, the bishop believes that "hope is a practice of God's creative freedom at play in human creativity and freedom.

"I believe hope knows the present is held with a comma, and that God's word is always breaking in for good. We as the church may be smaller than we once were, but I believe we are not too small to steward the moral imagination of Jesus," he says.






